She met boys and girls who had some of the same doctors, some of the same surgeries and some of the same scars and for the first time in her life she felt like someone truly understood her in a way that no one else quite could no matter how hard we tried. This year Hailey was a leader in training so she got to meet some kids who were coming to Zajac for their first camp and she got to share in that amazing experience with them! Next summer after graduation Hailey is hoping to work at Zajac ranch as a camp counsellor to give back to kids who were just like her.
